

Summer Camp Important Information

To Bring:

Chore Boots- Each child will need a pair of boots to wear in the animal pens. They will not be allowed to go in the animal pens wearing street shoes.

Work Gloves- Each child will need a pair of garden type gloves to wear when interacting with the animals. Please make sure to put their name on them.

Water Bottle- Please send a water bottle with your child. We have a place to refill it if they need more water.

Lunch- Each day we will have time to eat our lunch. We do have a place to put their lunch in a refrigerator if needed.

Snack- We will provide a snack but if you want to send an additional snack, that is fine too.

Backpack- Please send your child with a backpack so we can keep all of their things organized in it.

Change of Clothes- Please send a change of clothes in their backpack to keep there all week to use if needed (yes- even the big kids may need a spare change of clothes- you never know what we may get into on the farm).

Other Info:

Sunscreen: Please put sunscreen on your child before they come. We will be outside for several hours. We are more than happy to reapply if you want us to, just let us know.

Bug Spray: If you would like, you are welcome to spray your child with bug spray before they come. We may spend time in the woods.

Clothing: It is important to know what we spend most of our time outside. Please dress your child appropriately for the weather that day.

Scratches/scrapes: Since we are outside most of the day, kids are going to get scratches from time to time. If your child gets more than a scratch (bumped head, larger scrap or cut, etc), a teacher will notify you at pick up. If there is a medical emergency during farm school, a teacher will call you. We will start with the parent numbers provided and then move on to the emergency contacts provided.
